 Feel like their work makes a difference to the school community Treat everyone as an equal and always be respectful towards each other Ensure guests leave meetings with a positive view of the PC and what it is trying to achieve Respect and keep to the decisions made at PC meetings Be involved and help out wherever possible Work with the utmost integrity, specifically in dealing with financial matters Declare any conflict of interest and avoid situations which could cause improper conduct Be aware only members of the PC have a right to vote 	 Discuss personal issues relating to individual children, parents or school staff Discuss sensitive PC matters on social media Post content on social media that is negative or abusive towards the school or members of its community Discuss issues with the media without prior agreement

PC Principles

- Time should be used effectively
- Everyone should be given a chance to speak and to be heard, directed by the Chair
- All speakers should address the Chair
- Members should contribute constructively at meetings
- Each contribution should be valued and respected
- No member of Parent Forum/guests should leave feeling belittled or excluded
- Decisions will be made in the best interests of the whole school community
