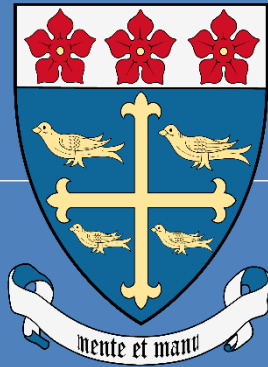

## Step 1: Register

Scan the QR Code or follow the link above and click 'register' in the top right hand corner. When registering please use the **main contact** email address that is on your child's school record (e.g. SEEMIS/School Database) to register. This will be the easiest and quickest way to book

## Step 2: Book your child's place(s)

Insert the booking code 001 into the search box. You can select 5 clubs that your child wishes to attend. Your place(s) will be reserved for 15 minutes while you complete your booking, and a confirmation email will be sent on completion

## Step 3: View booked activities

Visit your dashboard to see the activities your child is booked into and the times

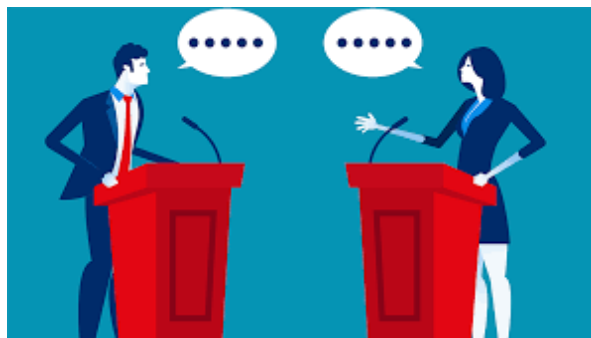

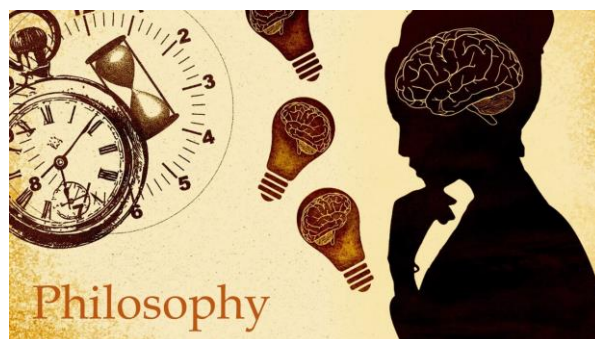

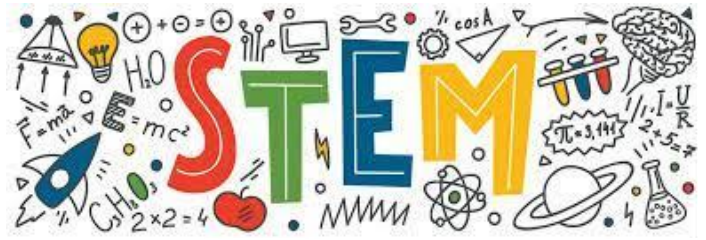
